DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

For use only when fertilizer and fungicide are required on Kentucky bluegrass, bentgrass fairways and putting greens, bluegrass-bentgrass mixtures, bluegrass-fine fescue mixtures, perennial ryegrass and tall fescue.

For use on lawn and turfgrass areas only. Fertilizes grass. Prevents and controls gray (*Typhula spp.*) and pink (*Fusarium nivale*) snow mold.

To prevent gray and pink snow mold on bluegrass, bluegrass blends with fine fescue or perennial ryegrass, bentgrass or bentgrass mixtures: Apply prior to the first heavy snow at the **RECOMMENDED RATE** (1.55 kg / 100 m²). In areas where snow cover is present the entire winter, use the **DOUBLE RATE** (3.1 kg / 100 m²). On mixtures containing bentgrass and on putting greens and tees containing bentgrass, limit application to mid-fall through the early-winter period.

To be used as part of a complete fertilizer program.

USE LIMITATIONS

Drop spreader application is preferred. Rotary spreader application should be made with extreme caution. Do not get product on operator or use on a windy day. Very slight but temporary yellowing of the grass may occur following treatment. To reduce temporary yellowing, water lightly to wash granules off the foliage if temperature is above 27° C (80° F) or if applied to moist foliage.
