GENERAL:

SKOOT Repellent for Rabbits, Mice and Deer is a formula developed after years of research. This chemical repellent is distasteful but harmless to rabbits, mice, and deer. The bad taste discourages feeding on any plants that have been treated by SKOOT Repellent for Rabbits, Mice and Deer. Shake well before using.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

For protection against rabbits, treat before snowfall, the area of any plant that may be reached by the rabbit.

Protection from mice can be assured by coating the base of plants thoroughly with SKOOT Repellent for Rabbits, Mice and Deer any time during the late fall.

Protection from deer is more difficult, and requires a light spraying of all susceptible plants.

SKOOT Repellent for Rabbits, Mice and Deer may be applied undiluted with a paint brush, or diluted with equal parts of water and applied with a pump-up or knapsack sprayer. Plants treated should be protected for one season. Do not allow SKOOT Repellent for Rabbits, Mice and Deer to freeze. SKOOT Repellent for Rabbits, Mice and Deer dries very quickly, therefore sprayers must be thoroughly flushed out with water immediately after spraying.

SKOOT Repellent for Rabbits, Mice and Deer concentrate when applied, will protect on an average the following number of plants, according to size:

Age	Approx. Height	Trees/litre
1yr.	0.3-0.5 metres	250-400
2yr.	0.5-1.0 metres	125-200
3yr.	1.0-2.0 metres	60-100
4yr.	1.0-2.5 metres	40-60
5yr.	2.0-4.0 metres	20-40

SKOOT Repellent for Rabbits, Mice and Deer can be safely applied to the following plants: dormant apple, ash, basswood, buckthorn, buffaloberry, cherry, crab apple, cranberry, dogwood, elm, euonymus, hackberry, honeysuckle, holly, indigo bush, juneberry, lespedeza, lilac, locust, magnolia, maple, olive, plum, poplar, prune, redbud, multiflora rose, tulip, arrowwood, and walnut.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

SKOOT Repellent for Rabbits, Mice and Deer is not recommended to be used on edible plant parts. Do not breathe spray mist. Keep container tightly closed to prevent evaporation. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Do not contaminate ponds, streams or other bodies of water.

FIRST AID:

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

IF SWALLOWED: Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

IF INHALED: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Treat symptomatically.

DISPOSAL:

1. Triple- or pressure-rinse the empty container. Add the rinsings to the spray mixture in the tank.
2. Follow provincial instructions for any required additional cleaning of the container prior to its disposal.
3. Make the empty container unsuitable for further use.
4. Dispose of the container in accordance with provincial requirements.
5. For information on disposal of unused, unwanted product, contact the manufacturer or the provincial regulatory agency. Contact the manufacturer and the provincial regulatory agency in case of a spill, and for clean-up of spills.
