With regard to order timing for many of our greenhouse and nursery products offerings, orders for most of these products, if we don't have them in stock, are placed on Thursday's and we typically have them at our door the following Thursday. Placing your order on Friday however means that it is closer to two weeks before the product arrives at Even Spray.

When do I place my Bio-orders?

Just a reminder that throughout last year that orders for biological pest control products changed, and that change holds for this year as well. Customer orders must be placed by Friday of any given week.

Using this Friday, March 5 as an example, if you place your order by Friday March 5 it is scheduled to arrive at Even Spray approximately 11 calendar days later on Tuesday, March 16. Please keep this in mind when doing your planning.
